NONPARTISAN RACES SUCH AS
SCHOOL BOARD AND JUDICIAL
RACES AS WELL AS UNIVERSAL
PRIMARY CONTESTS.**

**UNIVERSAL PRIMARY
CONTESTS OCCUR WHEN ALL
CANDIDATES FOR AN OFFICE
HAVE THE SAME PARTY
AFFILIATION AND THE WINNER
WILL HAVE NO OPPOSITION IN
THE GENERAL ELECTION, ALL
QUALIFIED ELECTORS,
REGARDLESS OF PARTY
AFFILIATION,
MAY VOTE IN THE PRIMARY
ELECTIONS FOR THAT OFFICE.**
