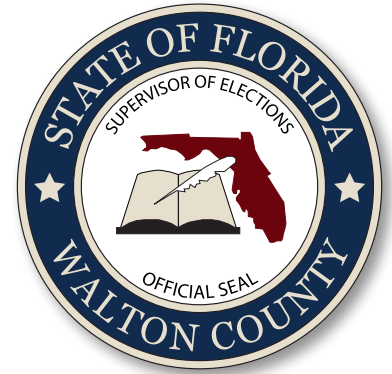

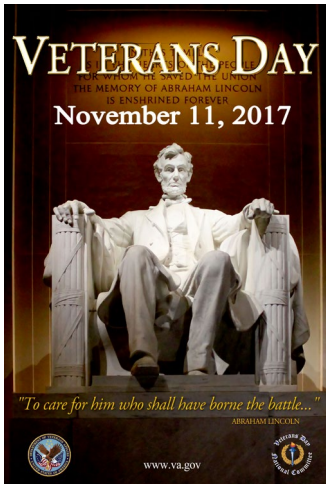

## Honoring Our Military Veterans

Veterans Day is an official United States federal holiday, observed annually on November 11th, that honors military veterans. Major hostilities of World War I were formally ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918.

## Pre-Register to Vote at age 16

If you are sixteen years old, a U.S. citizen and a legal resident of Florida, you may [preregister to vote](#). After your 18th birthday, we will mail you a voter information card. 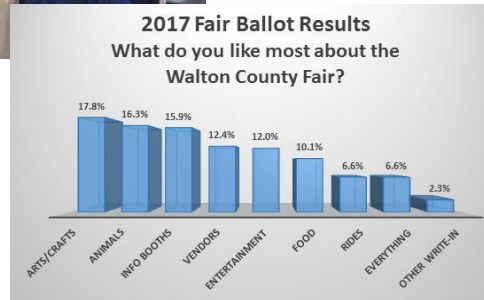

## Did you know?

Did you know that Florida's new online voter registration website was launched on October 1st? [RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov](http://RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov) is a convenient and secure way for you to submit your Voter Registration Application from anywhere! A Florida resident may still apply at the Supervisor of Elections Office, Tax Collector/Driver's License Office, public libraries and by mail.

You will need a Florida driver license (Florida DL) or Florida identification card (Florida ID card) issued by the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles and the last four digits of your social security number. State law requires this information to verify your identity. This helps protect against someone else trying to use your identity to register to vote. If you do not have any one or all of the information above, you may still use the online system to prefill a voter registration application form. However, you will have to print, sign, and then mail or deliver your completed voter registration application to your Supervisor of Elections' office.
