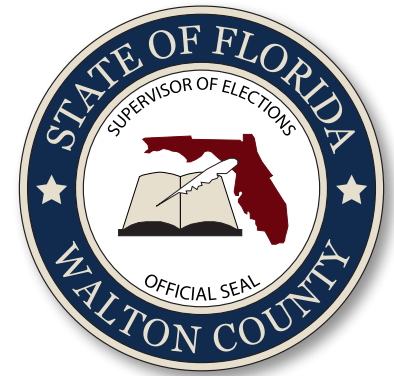

Voter Stats:

General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6th

The General Election is open to all voters registered by October 9, 2018. We encourage you to check your [Voter Status](#) to review your voter registration information, locate your polling location, view the sample ballot and more. Also on our website, we provide links for general [Voting Guides](#), Candidate Guides, Judicial Information Guides and Constitutional Amendment Guides. For your convenience, we offer you three ways to vote:

1. Vote by Mail

Voting by mail is easy, convenient, available to any voter, and no excuse is needed. [Request and track](#) your mail ballot at votewalton.com or call our office. If voting by mail, be sure your signature in your voter record is up-to-date. Vote by Mail ballots must be returned to the Elections Office by 7:00pm on Election Day, November 6, 2018.

2. Early Voting

Early Voting is easy and convenient and available to any voter. Eligible Walton County voters may vote at any one of the Early Voting locations. Be sure to bring proper photo and signature [identification](#).

If you choose to vote on Election Day, November 6, 2018, you must go to your home precinct's polling place to do so. On Election Day, the polls are open from 7:00am until 7:00pm. 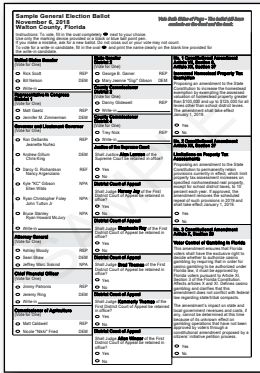

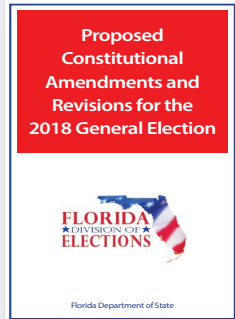

New Early Voting Site

Voting by mail, early voting, and voting at your precinct on Election Day are three ways you can choose to vote. Faith Assembly Church in Miramar Beach has been added to the list of early voting sites! Eligible Walton County voters may vote at any one of the four Early Voting locations.

Did you know?

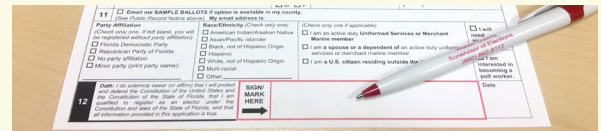
When voting in person, by provisional ballot, or Vote by Mail ballot, Florida election law requires each voter to sign a Voter's Certificate. While an exact match of a voter's signature is not required, the signature should reasonably match the signature of record.

All voters should consider periodically updating their signature on file with our office. Ensuring that the signature on file with our office is current will help alleviate delays at the polls when matching the signature at check in, and can prevent a Vote by Mail ballot from being disqualified due to a non-matching signature.

Voters should update their signature if:

- Voter signature has changed over time.
- Voter updated signature at Driver License office and experienced difficulty with electronic signature pad.
- Voter decided to change the style of signature.
- Voter adopted different styles of signature for professional and personal use.
- Voter name changed.
- Voter has hand injury or change in motor skills.
- Last signature on file is over 10 years old and may lack sufficient detail for comparison with current signature.

To update your signature, complete a paper [Voter Registration Application](#) and mail or deliver to our office.

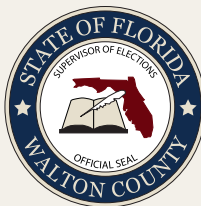
