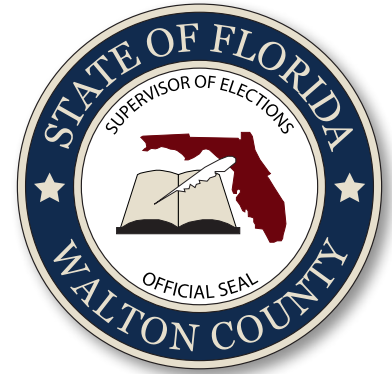

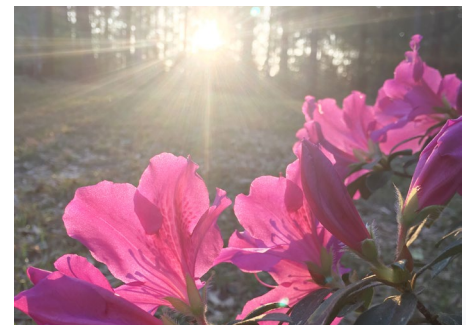

High-throughput Scanner & Tabulator

We're happy to announce the acquisition of a new high-speed scanner/tabulator called the DS450 from ES&S. As we continue to grow and evolve in how elections are conducted, this central count scanner brings needed speed, sorting, and versatility to our office. The DS450 will be used to tabulate vote-by-mail ballots, provisional ballots, and will assist in conducting audits and canvassing write-in votes. It will also help greatly in the case of a recount. 2018 Election Dates:

Eligible individuals can register to vote at any time. The deadline to register in order to participate in an upcoming election is 29 days before the election. The deadline for Party Affiliation changes is 29 days before an election.

May 21, 2018: Candidate(s) for County & District Office Petition Deadline

June 18 noon - June 22 noon, 2018: County & District Office Qualifying

August 18-25, 2018: Early Voting - Primary Election

August 28, 2018: Primary Election Day

Oct 27 - Nov 3, 2018: Early Voting - General Election

November 6, 2018: General Election Day
