13 Proposed Amendments for November's Ballot

Once every 20 years, Florida's Constitution provides for the creation of a 37-member revision commission for the purpose of reviewing Florida's Constitution and proposing changes for voter consideration. The Constitution Revision Commission (CRC) Chairman Carlos Beruff, said, "For more than a year, Commissioners have traveled across the state to speak directly with citizens about the changes they want to see in the Florida Constitution. After months of in-depth research and debate, the CRC has narrowed down thousands of comments and ideas into eight final revisions for voter consideration. From protecting our state and territorial waters from oil drilling to strengthening our ethics laws, I commend my fellow Commissioners for their hard work and leadership representing the people of Florida. We are grateful to the thousands of Floridians who participated in this historic process and look forward to letting voters have the final say in November."

Proposed constitutional revisions on the ballot must secure at least 60 percent voter approval to become law. A list of the eight revisions and the full text of each revision is available on FLCRC.gov. These eight revisions join two approved petition drives and three measures approved by the Florida Legislature. There will also be a County Referendum on the November ballot.

Your Supervisor of Elections office will provide the amendments and referendum text when the sample ballot is available, so that you can be well informed in your decisions. You may want to take advantage of Early Voting (dates noted below) or have a ballot mailed to you. Preregister at 16, vote at 18

Your Walton County Supervisor of Elections and staff have been visiting and making available Voter Registration Applications to Walton County High School students. Pre-registration is available for eligible 16 and 17 year olds by paper form and online at votewalton.com or RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov. Teens who pre-register to vote will have their voter information card mailed to them on their 18th birthday.

The deadline to register to vote is 29 days before any election. You may update your registration record at any time, but for a Primary Election, party changes must be completed 29 days before Election Day.

To submit an online application, you will need:

- ✔ Your Florida Driver License or Florida ID Card issued by the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles.

To protect your identity, you will need:

- ✔ The issued date of your Florida DL or Florida ID card; and
- ✔ The last four digits of your Social Security Number.
