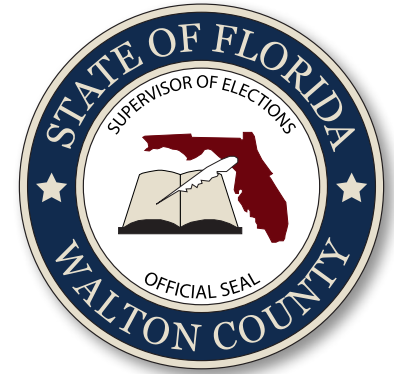

Voter Stats:

Primary Election - August 28th

Primary Election Day is August 28, 2018. To check your [Voter Status](#), see your sample ballot and more, visit [votewalton.com](#). For your convenience, we offer you **3 ways to vote**:

1. Mail

Voting by mail is easy, convenient, available to any voter, and no excuse is needed. [Request and track](#) your mail ballot at [votewalton.com](#) or call our office. If voting by mail, be sure your signature in your voter record is up-to-date. Vote by Mail ballots must be returned to the Elections Office by 7:00pm on Election Day, August 28, 2018.

2. Early Voting

Early Voting is easy and convenient, available to any voter, and no excuse is needed. Eligible Walton County voters may vote at *any* one of the Early Voting locations. Be sure to bring proper [photo ID](#) and signature identification.

3. Election Day

If you choose to vote on Election Day, August 28, 2018, you must go to your home precinct's polling place to do so. On Election Day, the polls are open from 7:00am until 7:00pm. To find your polling place, look at your voter information card, or go to [votewalton.com](#). Be sure to bring proper [photo ID](#) and signature identification.

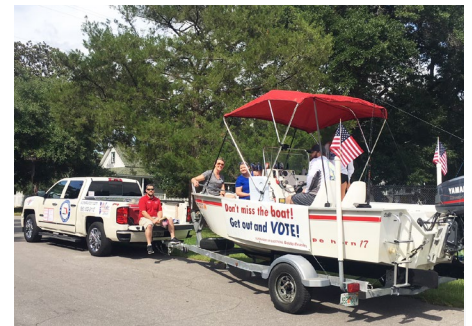

ELECTION DAY If you choose to vote on Election Day, August 28th, you should go to your home precinct polling place by 7:00 am. If you are unable to get to your polling place, take your voter information card, or go to VoterWALTON.com to locate your info.</p> <p>Before voting: • Be sure your registration information is up-to-date. • If voting at the polls, be sure to bring proper photo and signature identification. Get the list at VoterWALTON.com. • If voting by mail, be sure your signature on your voter request is legible.</p> <p>What is a Primary Election? A Primary Election is an election held preceding the General Election for the purpose of narrowing a party's nominees to candidates for the General Election. It is a method of electing candidates. Only all candidates are voting with the same party affiliation and there is no separate for the General Election. There are no "runoff" elections. Runoff elections are held for positions where there are no candidates in the election.</p> <p>Registration and Party Change Deadline The deadline for a voter to register or change their party affiliation is July 30, 2018.</p>

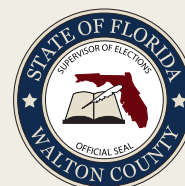
