Voters who reside in Walton County and are registered in Florida before the deadline.

Registration Deadline:

April 8th, 2019 at 5:00 pm

Vote by Mail (Absentee):

Visit VoteWalton.com or call (850) 892-8112 to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot. You may also track your mail ballot status at VoteWalton.com. The last day to request a ballot to be mailed is May 1st.

The first day a designee can pick up a ballot for another voter is May 2nd. Vote-by-Mail ballots must be returned to the Elections Office by Election Day, May 7th, at 7:00 pm

Thu - Fri, April 25th - 26th (8:30 am - 4:30 pm)

Mon - Sat, April 29 - May 4th (8:30 am - 4:30 pm)

May 7th, 2019 (7:00 am - 7:00 pm)
