Election Information

- **To vote in the City of Freeport Municipal Election, you must be a registered voter and reside in the city limits of Freeport. Registration books close to new registrations on June 9th, 2014 at 5 pm.**
- **To request an absentee ballot, contact the Freeport City Hall by phone at (850) 835-2822. Absentee ballots may also be voted or picked up and returned to the Freeport City Hall located at: 112 St Hwy 20 West, Freeport, FL 32439.**
- **Absentee Voting begins June 17, 2014. Designees may begin picking up absentees on July 3, 2014. All absentee ballots must be received at the Freeport City Hall by 7 pm on July 8, 2014 to be counted.**
- **Election Day voting will be held on July 8, 2014 from 7 am - 7 pm at the Freeport Community Center located at: 16040 331 Business, Freeport, FL 32439. A.D.A. equipment is available upon request at the polling place.**
- **A Public Logic & Accuracy Testing of ballots and voting equipment to be used in the City of Freeport Election will be held on Monday, June 30, 2014 at 3:30 pm in the office of the Supervisor of Elections in the courthouse in DeFuniak Springs.**
- **Canvassing of absentee ballots will begin at 6 pm on July 8, 2014 in the Freeport City Council Chambers.**
- **The Post-Election Audit of the City of Freeport Election will be held on Friday, July 11, 2014 at 3:30 pm in the office of the Supervisor of Elections in the Courthouse in DeFuniak Springs. All canvassing board meetings are open to the public.**
