Want to Vote By Mail?

For your convenience, any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot. Avoter, member of the voter's immediate family or legal guardian may request an absentee ballot in person, by mail or by telephone. One request can cover all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections.

Call the Elections Office at (850) 892-8112. All voted absentee ballots must be in the Supervisor's Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day, in order to be counted.



SIGNATURE UPDATE

Any time there is a change in your signature or identifying "mark", you must complete a new registration application & submit it to the Elections Office. If your signature on your voter record and the signature on your absentee ballot do not match, your absentee ballot will not count.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot.
