Want to Vote By Mail?

For your convenience, any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot. A voter, member of the voter's immediate family or legal guardian may request an absentee ballot in person, by mail or by telephone. One request can cover all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections.

Call the Elections Office at (850) 892-8112. All voted absentee ballots must be in the Supervisor's Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day, in order to be counted.



SIGNATURE UPDATE

Any time there is a change in your signature or identifying "mark", you must complete a new registration application & submit it to the Elections Office. If your signature on your voter record and the signature on your absentee ballot do not match, your absentee ballot will not count.

It is a felony to vote in a precinct in which you do not reside. If your address has changed, please contact the Elections Office BEFORE you go to the polls to vote, so we can save you time!

HOW TO MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot.

You must completely fill in the oval for your vote to count.

Please, do **not** use a check mark; do **not** mark the oval with an X; and do **not** circle the oval.

Florida is a closed primary state. In primary elections, registered voters can only vote for their registered party's candidates in a partisan race on the ballot. The

March 15th, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary Election ballot only contains races for Republican and Democratic candidates for President. Therefore, only voters who are registered with Republican or Democratic party affiliations by the book closing deadline at 5 p.m. on Feb. 16th, 2016 will be eligible to vote in this election.
